This set of instructions is in the style and format to be used by authors preparing abstracts. Please follow this example and these instructions when typing your abstract.

The abstract file can be sent and updated until the submission deadline (15 January, 2012) only by e-mail to: nanosea2012@gmail.com

The abstract must be prepared in Microsoft Word; it should be written in English and should be single-spaced throughout. The requested type face is Times New Roman, font size 12. Abstract should not exceed 1500 characters, in a A4 sized page (i.e. 210 x 297 mm) with the top margin measuring 3 cm and the other ones measuring 2.5 cm. The abstract should be headed by the title, author(s), affiliation(s) and address(es). The name of the presenting author has to be underlined. The e-mail address of the presenting author must be reported in the last line of the affiliations section.

The text should begin two lines below the author/affiliation section.
